

## Viewing and Printing the Flappers Newsletter

There is a "movie" on the cover of the newsletter. You need Adobe Reader 9 (or Acrobat 9) or higher in order to see the movie. If you do not see anything moving on the cover when you open the newsletter, then please go to the [Adobe Reader download page](#), and click the *Download Now* button to download and install the latest release of Adobe Reader. It only takes around 4 minutes to download and install if you have a high speed Internet connection, and it's free.

- Click on any item in the Table of Contents on page 2 to jump directly to that item.
- Whenever you see 'continued on page n' or 'continued from page n' at the end or beginning of an article segment, click on that text to jump to the continued part. This is not too useful if the continuation is on the following or preceding page, but if the continuation is a few pages away, it can be very convenient.
- On the bottom right corner of each page, except the cover, you will see 'Table of Contents'. Click this link or the arrow right before it to jump to the beginning of the Table of Contents. On the cover, you can click the invisible link in the upper right corner or lower right corner to jump to the Table of Contents.
- For our advertisers that have a web site, you can click anywhere in the advertisement to go to that web site. You do not have to look for the *www* link to click. Of course you have to be connected to the Internet for this to work.
- Wherever you see a web address that begins with 'www.' (this is called a URL), you can click it to go to that web page. Sometimes these URLs are in blue and underlined to make it obvious that you can click them, but you can click on any URL whether or not it is in blue or underlined. The same applies to an email address; just click on it to send a message to that address if your computer is set up to automatically launch your email program. Again, you have to be connected to the Internet before these clicks will work.
- Wherever you see "... on page n", click on "page n" to jump directly to that page. These links are usually underlined in blue.
- **If you see a photo in the newsletter with an arrow in the middle of it or surrounded by a blue border, it means you can click the photo to watch an associated video (assuming you are connected to the Internet).**
- Before printing the newsletter, it is best to first disable the movie on the cover to make sure that the cover prints properly. To do so, right click the movie and select 'Disable Content'.
